## Audience Sentiment Survey Summary

On April 21-22, 2020, we ran a six-question, multiple-choice survey through RACER.com, prompted by the graphic shown to the right from which we received 3,756 responses (approximately 300 of which came in after the promotion period).

The aim of the survey was to get a sense of audience engagement and mood as the effects of the COVID-19 outbreak has taken hold and caused an unprecedented disruption to motorsports and life as whole. In summary, the results show that our audience remains highly engaged, open to new ways to get their racing fixation met such as through virtual racing and are cautiously optimistic about the near future of the sport.

The majority of our audience looks forward to returning to events, albeit with more precautions befitting the current state of affairs.

Most assuring is that the overall trend of the responses indicates that survey participants took the questions seriously and answered them thoughtfully and honestly.




## Audience Sentiment Survey Summary



Has your engagement with motorsport changed with the pause in racing?



Answered: 3,736 / Skipped: 20




## Audience Sentiment Survey Summary



When do you think it's appropriate for the major series to get back to racing?


Answered: 3,741 / Skipped: 15

Answered: 3,749 / Skipped: 7




## Audience Sentiment Survey Summary



How would you feel about racing events taking place without a live audience?


Answered: 3,742 / Skipped: 14
